OCEAN CARRIER CMA CGM BUYS INGRAM MICRO'S E-COMMERCE UNIT FOR BILLION \$3

French ocean shipping and logistics firm CMA CGM Group said Wednesday it will acquire most of the e-commerce and life cycle unit of technology distribution giant Ingram Micro for US\$3 billion, a move designed to deepen CMA CGM's footprint in the logistics business and build end-to-end supply chain solutions for its customers.

CMA CGM said the assets will be combined with those of Ceva Logistics, the contract logistics firm it acquired in 2019. CMA CGM said it paid for the Ingram Micro assets with internally generated funds.

When the deal closes during the first half of 2022, Ceva will become the world's fourth-largest contract logistics provider, with 1,100 locations in 160 countries, CMA CGM said. Contract logistics providers manage complex warehouse and distribution operations for big companies that no longer choose to do it themselves.

The Ingram Micro unit specializes in e-commerce contract logistics and omnichannel fulfillment. CMA CGM will acquire the unit's businesses in North America, Europe, Asia-Pacific and Latin America, as well as Shipwire, a cloud-based logistics platform. Ingram Micro will retain the rest of the unit's operations, which include the North American and European reverse logistics businesses.

DP WORLD ANNOUNCES DEVELOPMENT PARTNERSHIP WITH EMERGENT COLD LATIN AMERICA BILLION

Emergent Cold Latin America (Emergent LatAm), Latin America's newest temperature-controlled warehousing and logistics provider, and DP World, a global logistics company and one of the world's largest marine terminal operators, announced their intention to partner on the development of two temperature-controlled logistics facilities within DP World Logistics Parks in Latin America. These developments will provide Emergent Cold LatAm and DP World customers with a fully integrated supply chain solution.

The developments will be focused on two locations:

- DP World Caucedo (Dominican Republic) is a world-class Logistics Hub and free trade zone located in Punta Caucedo, near the city of Santo Domingo. Caucedo is the newest and most modern port on the island, and a gateway for the Caribbean food trade.
- Duran Logistics Center (Ecuador) began operations in September 2020 as part of a large investment in this important global trade market. Ecuador's main export commodities include shrimp and bananas.

The parties have also committed to explore development activities in other DP World locations in Latin America to enhance their service offerings and further establish a cold-chain footprint.

PORT OF VANCOUVER SHIP BACKLOG HITS 60

The Port of Vancouver hit a grim milestone this week as the number of ships waiting for a berth reached 60 despite the resumption of rail service.

It happened Tuesday night, and included nine containers, 17 grain and 16 coal vessels. The number had dipped to 57 as of late Wednesday.

The Vancouver Fraser Port Authority, in an operations update Wednesday, reported that "anchorage demand continues to exceed capacity" as Canada's largest port continues to battle the impacts of the flooding and landslides that hit British Columbia in mid-November, cutting off CN (NYSE:CNI) and Canadian Pacific (NYSE:CP) rail service.

While CN and CP have since reopened their rail lines serving the port — between Kamloops and Vancouver — they still aren't operating at full capacity. And the volume of containers has picked up, particularly since CN began moving trains between Kamloops and Vancouver over the weekend.
