CHINESE LARGE UAV COMPLETES FIRST MIDDLE EAST LOGISTICS FLIGHT

As the transportation minister of the Sultanate of Oman gently pressed the take-off countdown button, the "Archer" large, unmanned transport aircraft, carrying 60 kilograms of medical supplies, flew through the 3,352-meter-high Hajar mountains and delivered the goods to a mountainous town 100 kilometers away.

The aircraft completed its delivery in less than 50 minutes, marking the first commercial logistics flight of a Chinese large-scale UAV in the Middle East.

This landmark mission, named "Sky Bridge," was executed

by Times Flying Phoenix Technology Co., Ltd., a high-tech enterprise initiated by China Aerospace Science and Technology Corporation and based in Kunshan, China. Backed by Oman's Ministry of Transport, Ministry of Health and Civil Aviation Authority, the flight demonstrates the capability of Chinese-manufactured large UAV systems to operate reliably in harsh environments characterized by high temperatures, sandstorms and strong winds, and represents the systematic introduction of China's low-altitude economic solutions in the Middle East.

ETIHAD AIRWAYS TO MAKE HISTORY AS FIRST MIDDLE EAST AIRLINE TO FLY TO LUXEMBOURG

Ethiad Airways has announced the launch of flights to Luxembourg, marking a historic milestone as the first airline from the Middle East to serve the country. When services commence on 29 October 2026, Etihad will also become the only airline offering nonstop flights between Luxembourg and Abu Dhabi, creating a new direct air link between two important European and Middle Eastern centres.

The new route reflects growing demand from travellers across Luxembourg, the Benelux region, France and Germany for direct access to Abu Dhabi. Services will operate to Luxembourg Airport (LUX), providing guests with direct access to the beautiful emirate of Abu Dhabi, the UAE's vibrant capital and a gateway to Arabian culture, world-class hospitality and year-round sunshine.

Flights will operate three times weekly using Etihad's state-of-the-art A321LR, offering guests the most premium direct travel option between Luxembourg and the UAE. The A321LR features the airline's acclaimed three-class cabin, including first suites and lie-flat business seats all with direct aisle access, delivering elevated comfort, privacy and Etihad's renowned hospitality throughout. Next-generation economy seats feature generous legroom, 4K touchscreen TVs and Bluetooth pairing; all complemented by high-speed Wi-Fi throughout the aircraft.

BARQ AND ELROY AIR TEAM UP FOR \$200M AIRCRAFT MANUFACTURING PLANT IN ABU DHABI

Abu Dhabi smart mobility company Barq Group has teamed up with Elroy Air to develop a manufacturing facility in the emirate for the US logistics firm's unmanned Chaparral cargo aircraft, helping to advance the UAE's autonomous goals.

The joint venture will invest \$200 million in the project to produce the Chaparral, an uncrewed hybrid-electric vertical take-off and landing (VTOL) cargo system, the companies said in a statement on Friday.

The development aims to establish local production capacity serving the UAE and wider Middle East and North Africa, where demand for autonomous logistics is growing, they said.

The partnership is a "commitment to building a self-sustaining aerospace ecosystem", and is aligned with the Make it in the Emirates campaign and Abu Dhabi's Smart and Autonomous Vehicles Industry cluster, said Ahmed AlMazrui, chief executive of Barq Group.
